## Brief outline of course

The Level 2 Certificate in Personal Finance has been designed for students who are, or will shortly be, starting on a period of life when they can no longer depend on others for their financial provision. In particular, learners will consider the legal and practical constraints on the sources and uses of money; the methods of organising their money through personal budgeting; the considered use of appropriate bank and building society accounts and the concept and consequences of overspending or payment default.

The aim is to increase learners' understanding of everyday financial encounters, enabling them to make informed decisions about their finances. They will also develop a good working knowledge of money management and increase their understanding of the banking systems available to them to make informed choices about their bank account and spending decisions. Learners will develop an understanding of the consequences of overspending.
